MAJ. GEN. ARTHUR M. BARTELL BECOMES PRESIDENT OF ARMY AND NAVY ACADEMY

On January 17, 2014, the Army and Navy Academy community will gather to formally bid a fond farewell to Brig. Gen. Stephen M. Bliss, USA Retired who grew and strengthened the Academy during his 12+ year tenure as President, and to welcome its incoming President, Maj. Gen. Arthur M. Bartell, USA Retired.

In keeping with military protocol, a formal Change of Command Ceremony will begin at 10:00 a.m. on the morning of Friday, January 17, 2014, on Maffucci Field at the Duffield Sports Center Complex. As a student leader in Army and Navy Academy's Corps of Cadets, FIRST LAST of CITY will be participating in the ceremony.

"As I prepare to join the Army and Navy Academy Family," states Maj. Gen. Bartell, "I am filled with anticipation, excitement, and pride. I have embraced the Academy's strategic plan that has us on a values-based trajectory to achieve our vision of being a premier, internationally recognized military boarding school for young men, and I pledge all of my energy to ensure we stay focused on that task."

Founded in 1910, the Army and Navy Academy is a private not-for-profit institution that provides an academically robust, character-based education for young men, grades 7 through 12. It is the only private boarding school in San Diego County and the only private military academy for high school-age students in California and surrounding states.
