## FAQs

#### SENIOR BACCALAUREATE

#### Q: How much are Senior Banquet tickets for additional guests?

**A:** Tickets are \$45.00 for additional guests. Each Cadet will receive two complimentary tickets for the family.

#### Q: Is there a max number of guests allowed per family?

A: No, each Cadet may invite as many guests to attend the dinner with them as long as additional guests have a paid ticket. Each guest above 12 years of age must register.

#### Q: What is the deadline for registration?

**A:** The last day to register for the Senior Banquet & Baccalaureate Service is May 10, 2024. After this date admittance will be considered on a case by case basis by emailing Ms. Ariel Locke at alocke@armyandynavyacademy.org.

#### Q: Are children allowed to attend?

**A:** Yes, children under 12 years of age are free to attend. Anyone over the age of 12 must register.
